Kids Who Care Not Waiting for Superman with Original Musical “District XI-Believe in Me!”

Non-Profit Youth Theatre Group to Perform at Four Local Boys & Girls Clubs and Fort Worth ISD School in November as Part of “Kids in the Community” Outreach Performance Program

FORT WORTH, TX – November 3, 2010 – Kids Who Care, a non-profit international musical theatre company based in Fort Worth, Texas, today announced additional performance dates for its 2010-2011 Kids Who Care Resident Company, as part of the organization’s outreach performance program called Kids in the Community. Kids in the Community takes the performing arts to underserved youth across North Texas, performing at schools, community youth programs and non-profit events with messages of hope and empowerment.

Kids Who Care will be performing selections from its original and popular *District XI - Believe in Me!* musical November 10, 12, 15 and 17 at 5:00 p.m. at four branches of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Fort Worth and November 19 at 8:00 a.m. at Dolores Huerta Elementary in the Fort Worth Independent School District (ISD).

Kids Who Care’s *District XI - Believe in Me!* musical was written by Texas songwriters and playwrights and was inspired by the YouTube video of 10-year-old Dalton Sherman's convocation speech to Dallas ISD teachers and staff, imploring them to believe in themselves and their students. Set in the halls and classrooms of elementary, middle and high schools, *District XI* is a fun, timeless look at school that also tackles issues that plague our education system.

"Since 1989, Kids Who Care has always performed at places that matter and make a difference in our community," said Deborah Jung, founding and executive director of Kids Who Care. "Part of our mission is to take messages of hope and empowerment to underserved youth in the Dallas/Fort Worth area. Tight now, there is no message that is more important than our children’s education, and we believe that there are no messengers more powerful than our children.”

The upcoming Kids in the Community outreach performances by Kids Who Care is supported by a Neighborhood Arts Program grant from the Arts Council of Fort Worth & Tarrant County.
