Kids Who Care Camp spans two weeks including:

Week One: The Musical & Ensemble

This week dives into the musical in typical summer-stock style. Team building exercises, acting techniques, music and choreography rehearsals, all play a part in creating the classical musical. The group shifts to thinking like a theatre company as the show is learned and mastered.

Week Two: The Production

This week the professional technical and artistic team becomes visible to create the finished product and interface with the cast. This team includes a professional production manager, lighting designer, stage manager, costume designer, scenic designer, sound engineer, and full technical crew backstage. The production is sold to a legitimate audience for a 2 performance run in the Scott Theatre located Fort Worth's Cultural District

Daily Camp Activities for Classic Musical Theatre Camp

Greeting of the Day 9:00-9:15 a.m.

The day begins with announcements! This includes everything from the theatre word of the day, birthday celebrations, rehearsal information, lunch clean-up teams, and any other information pertinent to the day's goals.

Daily Physical / Vocal Warm Ups 9:15-9:45
